Amendments to the Construction Code for Pressure Vessels (Notification No.196 of the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare, 2003), which aims to (1) delete corrosion allowance (the additional thickness required for corrosion and mechanical abrasion resistance) from the minimum thickness of the Class-1 and Class-2 pressure vessels and (2) harmonize to the latest revision of relevant Japan Industrial Standards.

- 7. Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable: In order to prevent occupational accidents due to Class-1 and Class-2 pressure vessels.
